1. Current plan and comments from Paula Plant:

Current trust land plan was reviewed with comments from Paula Plant. Mrs. Amsden has a saved message from Paula that explains what needs to happen on the plan if there was an audit. The council is clear on the difference between the goals. Goal #1 and Goal #3 do not have the same paraprofessionals. Goal #1 is based on attendance and reading and Goal #3 is just reading. The council agreed to leave the plan as is without an amendment. If an amendment still needs to be made it can be voted upon at the January meeting.

2. Current Expenditures:

\$2311.99 of the \$2500 has been spent for magazine periodicals to be used in classrooms. \$3795.00 of the \$3900.00 has been used for Dream box Licenses. \$286.21 of the \$1000 has been used for general supplies. Approximately \$1000 has been used for substitute teachers for professional development workshops. \$10,000 has been used of the \$42,000 budget for Aide Salaries. No questions or concerns came up during financial review.

3. Upcoming Plan Ideas:

Ten Marks is a computer program that 4th grade uses and is piloting for the school for the 2017-2018 school year. Members of the council were asked to have their children use the 30-day trial at home and bring feedback for the next meeting, to see if that is a program, we would like to purchase for all upper grade students for next year. We are not sure that ALEKS will be available to schools next year and we need a math program for students to use during PLC time. Discussion around an additional set of Chrome books, and Aide salaries / use of aides in the older grade classrooms were ideas for next year. Headphones for the computer lab are needed, but the council did not feel this would be something we would want to use Trust land money for this purchase. No decisions were made for the upcoming plan, rather discussion and ideas to bring to the next meeting in January.
