Topics Discussed

- 1. Review of meeting minutes by Chair Morgan Wilkins (approved by Jenae Clegg).
- 2. Current Trustland goal and finance review by Tana Chipp.
 - Our goal for reading is for 65% of students in K-6 to achieve a Pathway of Progress score that indicates typical or above growth from the beginning-of-year to end-of-year administration of the Acadience Reading Assessment.
 - We also hope to have 80% of students on monthly benchmark goals in Math.
 - Funds are currently being used for an IXL & Imagine Learning subscription, Chromebook lease,
 hiring of staff to provide support, professional development for staff, and reading materials.
 - Tana is working to have the installment of Newline boards to be finished in all classrooms.
 Currently there is a hold due to the building of new schools and taking down of Roosevelt Elementary school.
 - In the coming year Washington Terrace Elementary will be taking in temporally displaced students from Roosevelt, so the funding is subject to adjustment based on what is received or allotted to support the increase of students.
 - School plan was voted on and approved by the 7 members present.
- 3. A few topics were discussed that are happening at the school.
 - Standard response protocol has been posted all throughout the school and reviewed to
 reinforce the routines and procedures that are in place to keep our students and faculty safe.
 - Chair Morgan Wilkins is working on an application for Weber County RAMP funds for the playground.
